ADDITIONAL EXCURSION OPTIONS

- **Lekgalametsi Mountain Walk (7-8 hours)** - A day trip to the Drakensberg Mountains with a scenic walk, magnificent views and a picnic lunch.
- **Canyon Boat Trip (4-5 hours)** - A boat trip on the Blyde River Dam, see canyon from a different perspective.
- **Moholoholo Animal Rehabilitation Centre (4-5 hours)** - A guided tour of the centre will give you a close encounter with African birds of prey and its mammals: lion, cheetah, hyena and more.
- **Hoedspruit Shopping (4-5 hours)** - An opportunity for shopping in one of the local towns.
- **Orion - Stargazing (1.5 hours)** - After your evening meal drive to a quiet open area where your guide will introduce you to the African night sky.
- **Makutsi Walk (2-3 hours)*** - A guided walk on the reserve. Get closer to nature and enjoy the details.
- **Cheetah Research Drive (3-4 hours)*** - Join our guide on a research drive to try and find our Cheetah and rhino using radio tracking. Learn about Cheetah and their behavior.
- **Hot Air Balloon (2-3 hours)** - A lighter-than-air flight; enjoy a bird's eye view of the African Wilderness, African sunrise and the Drakensberg Mountains. Hot air ballooning in South Africa is arguably the best way to take in the landscapes of this beautiful country. Floating high above the ground, you have a spectacular, uninterrupted view of the gorgeous countryside below. Described as a somewhat magical experience, hot air ballooning is one of the oldest forms of flight known to man.
- **Makutsi Game Drive / Rhino Safari (3 hours)** - A game drive in an open vehicle in the early morning or late afternoon on the Makutsi Reserve.
- **Simba Safari (5 hours)** - An afternoon and early evening game drive in an open vehicle, stop and enjoy the sundown with refreshments.
- **Hatari Safari (10+ hours)** - Whole day bush experience with a walk, a midday brunch in the Hatari Camp and a game drive in an open vehicle in the afternoon to early evening.
